### Role

- Sole responsibility for developing Culture Bridge's Research Fellow Program

The Research Fellow program will complement Culture Bridges consulting services by providing policy recommendations from a research perspective. Research Fellows are engaged in in-depth research and the production of longer research articles on the topic of cross-cultural engagement and connection.

- Source and edit articles to be published on Culture Bridge's website and social media platforms (Facebook, LinkedIn)
- Recruit a list of regular contributors to write articles to be published on Culture Bridge's website and social media platforms
- Connect with academics and leaders in the private and public sector who are interested in the area of cross-cultural engagement and connection, providing them with information about Culture Bridge and its initiatives with the aim of encouraging them to write articles for Culture Bridge
- Liaise with co-founders and the national leadership team

### Time commitment

- 1 hour weekly national team meeting
- 4-6 hours weekly for February to develop Culture Bridge's Research Fellow Program and develop a list of contributors, to be reduced to 3-4 hours of editing and sourcing content
